

NAPLAN

The National Assessment Program for Literacy and Numeracy (N.A.P.L.A.N) is a national assessment and reporting program in the areas of reading, writing, numeracy and language conventions (spelling, grammar and punctuation) for students in Years 3 and 5. This testing will be conducted in week 5, this term.

Over the next couple of weeks, students will be completing practice tests at school. This will help them to understand the format of the questions and give them the experience of completing the test in the required test conditions (e.g. working silently and independently and within a time limit).
