A reminder that parents and students should only be inside the classrooms when with a teacher.

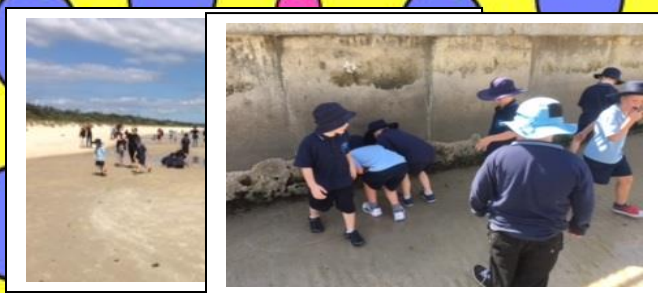
Our latest Transdisciplinary Theme 'How We Organise Ourselves' led us to the central idea: 'People consider the features of an area before settling'.
