YEAR 2 NEWSLETTER TERM 2

Literacy

For Writing this term, we will be exploring poetry. This will include the use of simile, rhyme and expressive language forms. Next we will explore persuasive writing, examining fact and opinion, and how these can be used to develop and expand a persuasive argument. Students will explore emotive language, conventions, and structures that suit persuasive writing.

We are thoroughly enjoying the newly implemented spelling program Little Learners Love Literacy. This term students will continue engaging in interactive spelling lessons that highlight a focus sound as well as elements of handwriting and letter formation.

In Reading, students are exploring the concept of 'relationships' in conjunction with our current unit of inquiry, 'Who We Are'. We have been reading different texts to learn about how relationships can affect our wellbeing and to help us develop strategies to nurture and maintain more positive relationships.

Homework

Homework is set each week to support the learning we are completing in the classroom. Students are expected to complete 4 nights of reading, and spelling tasks sent home for the week.

Curriculum

Unit of Inquiry Term 1 reflection

Our students explored the unit of inquiry 'How We Express Ourselves' in various ways in term 1.

2W explored what communication is and its different forms and purposes. They made a plan to communicate their individual passions and ideas through different modes of communication. 2K explored expressing a clear personal identity through story writing. 2R examined different communication techniques through history, including Egyptian hieroglphyics, Indigenous symbols and emojis. 2B demonstrated their learning by performing the AUSLAN alphabet as a form of communication at assembly. They did a wonderful job and it was fantastic to have the audience joining in too!

Unit of Inquiry Term 2

We have been exploring our Unit of Inquiry 'Who We Are' through the idea of relationships and their impact on our well-being. Students have been learning about healthy relationships and how to maintain these positively through empathy and kindness.

We are going to visit the Melbourne Museum later this term to support our next Unit of Inquiry 'Where we are in Place and Time'. Maths

We have been investigating measurement in the form of mass, capacity and volume this term. In the next few weeks we will be covering the concept of 'chance'. You may like to ask your child questions such as 'What is the chance of it raining today?' or 'What is the likelihood you will eat dinner tonight?' to elicit responses such as unlikely, likely, certain and impossible. Students have also been engaging in skip counting and multiplication, learning tactics to assist them in solving maths in both mental and written form.
