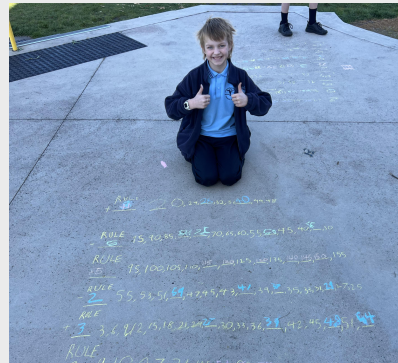
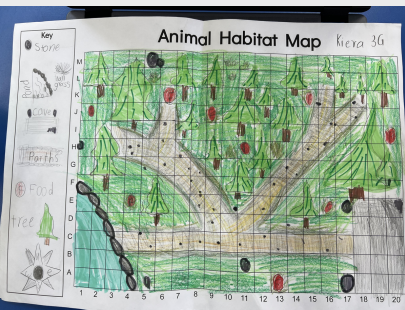

# MATHEMATICS

In Maths this term we are diving into multiplication and division. We will investigate the many representations of multiplication and division and learn a range of strategies to solve more complex problems using these operations.

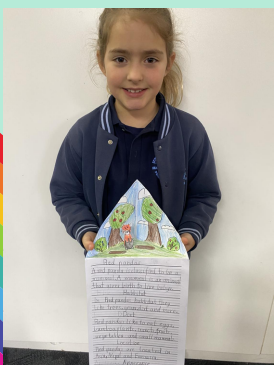
In connection with our current Unit of Inquiry, we have begun the term exploring mapping and location. Students have created maps of the habitats of different animals around the world using information they have collected through personal research. We will also be exploring chance and collecting and representing data.



# LITERACY

In Reading this term we are beginning our student bookclubs! The kids will be grouped based on their reading interests, then they will read a novel together and use comprehension strategies to comprehend and analyse their text.

In Writing, we are further investigating information reports and revisiting persuasive writing. The kids will be researching a topic of interest, organising their information using subheadings and presenting their findings in creative ways. During our persuasive unit, students will practise convincing their audience to agree with their opinion through the use of high-modality words and emotive language.



# UNIT OF INQUIRY

We have just wrapped up our third Unit of Inquiry. The students had a fantastic time visiting Melbourne Zoo and researching animals and biomes around the world.

We are beginning our next Unit of Inquiry, **Sharing The Planet**, with the central idea *The Earth's surface changes, generating opportunities for conservation and restoration.*
